With 176 verses, the psalm is the longest psalm as well as the longest chapter in the Bible. It is an acrostic poem, in which each set of eight verses begins with a letter of the Hebrew alphabet. The theme of the verses is the prayer of one who delights in and lives by the Torah, the sacred law. Unlike most other psalms, the author did not include his name in the text.

1 Timothy has 6 chapters (with 113 verses), and so might seem longer than books with only 4 or 5 chapters (and 104-108 verses); but 1 Timothy has only 1591 words in the original Greek NT text, and so is shorter than James (1742 words in Greek), and 1 Peter (1684 words), and even Philippians (1629 words), and is barely longer than Colossians (1582 words).
