Franz Kafka, the author has very nicely narrated the story of Gregou Samsa who wakes up one day to discover that he has metamorphosed into a bug. The book concerns itself with the themes of alienation and existentialism. The author has written many important stories, including ' The Judgement ' , and much of his novels ' Amerika ' , ' The Castle ' , ' The Hunger Artist ' . Many of his stories were published during his lifetime but many were not. Over the course of the 1920s and 30s Kafka ' s works were published and translated instantly becoming landmarks of twentieth-century literature. Ironically, the story ends on an optimistic note, as the family puts itself back together. The style of the book epitomizes Kafka ' s writing. Kafka very interestingly, used to present an impossible situation, such as a man ' s transformation into an insect, and develop the story from there with perfect realism and intense attention to detail. The Metamorphosis is an autobiographical piece of writing,
